

Target Field Station in Minneapolis' North Loop neighborhood is the city's state-of-the-art multi-modal transportation hub and grand public space. Sitting at the doorstep of Target Field Stadium, the station is the "Grand Central Station" of the Twins Cities, designed to inspire a civic identity and community pride in its mix of uses, central location, iconic, and purposeful design.



New to TFS

Case Study Findings

- 22 different community event planners
- 18 women, 4 men
- 16 women of color, 4 men of color
- Avg event per/planner: 4.7
- Avg numbers of guest(s) per/event: 71
- Avg % of POC/BIPOC attend per/event: Over 50%
- Of the 18 different event planners 16 referred others to TFS
- Over \$7,000 dollars raised in donations by community leaders

2021 TFS Updates

Hennepin County's Design & Construction Division. Hennepin County is currently in the final design phase to provide site security upgrades to the Target Field Station parking ramp.

What they doing

Hennepin County's capital construction project will provide enhanced site security to the Target Field Station parking ramp on all 3 levels. Adding high speed coiling grills, new digital signage, new cameras, new parking equipment, etc....

What is the timeline

Hennepin County tentatively plans to have a contract in place by early August, 2021. With construction starting on site in Mid-August, 2021. Construction is expected to last 70-100 days.

What can our stakeholder partners expect

Upon contract award to a general contractor. Hennepin County will hold kickoff meetings with all project stakeholders prior to construction. We'll provide weekly updates on construction schedules, update everyone on major milestones, and keep open communication throughout the entire duration of the project.
